MINUTES

Approve Meeting Minutes dated June 6, 2020. Melody motions to adopt the June minutes. Alex seconded. Motion passes.

PRINCIPAL and/or TEACHER REQUESTS/NEWS

- School News
 - o Bergeson



- Every child will get about 2.5 hours of instruction each day. 4th and 5th grade students will be split between their English and Mandarin teachers.
- Still working with teachers and teachers union to determine what it will look like when students return to school and some students continue to attend remotely
- Currently working to hire and train paraprofessionals for when students return to school.

Staffing Updates

 One of the Teaching Aides left, so there are currently 5 Mandarin Teaching Aides, expect that the District will fund these resources for the 2020-2021 school year. Teaching aides are hired for full time (30 hours/week) for this year.

DONATIONS, BUDGET AND FINANCIALS (TREASURER & FINANCIAL CONTROLLER)

- Financial Statements
 - Have spent approximately \$64k during this fiscal year
- Invoice approval and expense reimbursements
 - Expected to pay \$23k to teaching aides, but that is now anticipated to be covered by the District
- Audit status
 - Documents have been scanned through June so now have 13 months of statements that can be audited
- Chromebook refund
 - Expect to get \$16k check back from the District. It was sent but not cashed.
- DCP for Newhart
 - Currently paid through 8/31/20. Principal Murphine confirmed that this is covered by the District through 8/31/21.



- If it is to be covered by the District in future school years, it would need to be adopted by the District as part of the curriculum.
- Better Chinese Elementary
 - This is being covered by the District for the 2020-2021 school year.
- iChinese Reader
 - Need to confirm if this is still desired for Elementary
 - Greg recommended sending out a survey to determine if there is value to continue

 - Mary has offered to fill the Financial Controller position until we can find a replacement

 - Jenny can provide the list of Kindergarten families so we can reach out to them. Consider also reaching out to the first grade families to adopt a Kindergarten family.
